

Junior High Homework/Behavior Detention

The Homework/Behavior detention policy is designed to help students work up to their potential and ensure a safe and healthy learning environment.

Behavior points:

- 3 behavior points in one day will result in a 20-minute detention that afternoon. If the student cannot serve the detention that night they stay the next day.
-
- 6 points earned in a week is a behavior detention to be served the following Thursday.
- 9 points earns another 20-minute detention
- 12 points in a week is a Saturday school.

Homework Detention

- If a homework detention is earned the student stays at the least until 3:30 P.M. or 20 minutes.
- If the work for the homework detention is not completed by 3:30 P.M. then the student stays until 4 P.M. or when it is finished, whichever comes first.
- If a student has 2 or more homework detentions in one night they stay until 4 P.M.
- If any late homework is not done by 4 P.M. then the homework to be taken home, finished and turned in the next day.
- If the work is not done the next day, a new homework detention is earned.
- 5 homework detentions will result in a Saturday school.
- If a student cannot serve a homework detention, they will obtain the work from the teacher and finish the incomplete/late paper at home, serving the 20 minutes the next day. This is done to keep the student up-to-date as much as possible in his/her classes, and to use the time the next day to work on new homework, reinforcing the need to keep current in their work.
